Hello Bryan,

This past weekend, on Saturday, September 9, I visited the above referenced project and feel that the work was not done according to the "Request for Responses" associated with the project.

Section II A (Description of Desired Goods and Services) of the "Request for Responses" states in paragraph 3: "The work includes evaluation and removal deteriorating stone/masonry pillars (2). It also includes work to rebuild to match existing stonework." Be advised that the stone pillars were not removed nor rebuilt, but merely had the existing cracks parged over and tooled with mortar that does not match anything. The work done on the pillars was poor at best.

As you know, we were the second low bidder on the project. We request a copy of the Bidder's bid, a copy of the 100% payment and performance bonds, as well as the insurance certificates provided by the Bidder.


Also, provide us with the following information provided by the Bidder as noted in the Town of Natick's Response Form:

- Item F: List of references for 6 successfully completed project
- Item K: Letter of Good Standing from the Secretary of the Commonwealth's office
- Item O: OSHA 10-hour documentation

Lastly, we request Certified Payrolls for the project to date.

If this is the type of work that the town would accept from a "Historical Mason Contractor," then the tax payers of this town, which I am one, are not getting quality work for their dollar.
