Trish,  
The roadways in the Sherwood Neighborhood are included in this years annual roadway improvements contract. The roads have been included on the Board of Selectmen's Five Year Roadway Improvement Plan for some time. As has been standard practice for roadways of this type, a stone chip seal is planned for the final wearing surface of the roadways. The season for chip sealing roadways has ended, so the work to place the seal in this neighborhood has been scheduled for this coming spring.

The pavement currently in the neighborhood is a pavement leveling course, not a final wearing surface. Please note, that without a proper wearing surface the roadways in this neighborhood will deteriorate sooner. The use of stone chip seals is a common practice in the Commonwealth (it is used by many surrounding communities) and is approximately 1/4 of the cost of placing a 1 1/2" bituminous wearing course.

We would be happy to discuss with the Selectmen this winter when we bring forward the annual update to the Five Year Roadway Improvement Plan.
