As requested please find the attached plan indicating the proposed location of the storage structure. The structure would be placed behind the existing salt shed as viewed from Oak Street and would be of a similar size as the existing.

The storage structure would be used to store fire hydrants, water pipe, water fittings, trench backfill for winter repairs, equipment and the like. Currently these water materials are stored outside exposed to the elements (and buried in snow). We are bursting at the seams at [75 West Street](#) and at the Oak Street Pit. This storage building will give us more flexibility and allow us to store water materials in a more organized and sanitary way.
