

The Board of Selectmen has established a Seven Person Parking Advisory Committee for the purpose of evaluating and proposing a plan to develop both short and long-term parking solutions for the Town of Natick with a concentrated focus on Natick Center.

The composition of the committee is as follows:

- A member of the Board of Selectmen or designee
- The Community Development Director or his designee
- The Chief of Police or his designee
- A representative of Natick Center Associates
- Three (3) Citizens-at-large

Appointees to this committee are proposed to be individuals with professional backgrounds relevant to parking development and management, including parking structure and other capacity, and any related skills and experience.

The charge of the Committee is to review the January 2013 Cecil Group Evaluations and recommendations within the “Downtown Parking Strategy for Natick Town Center” report as well as any other parking studies or proposals that are available and consult with regional planning agencies to identify best practices. The Committee shall provide to the Board of Selectmen timely recommendations for both short and long-term parking solutions for the Town of Natick, with a concentrated focus on Natick Center, addressing all business, government, visitor, commuter and residential interests.
