Whittier Road has been recently resurfaced due to gas line replacement in the area. If it is not feasible to have the block party on Whittier Road then we would like to request that Orchard Road between Whittier and Wellesley be the alternate location for the same date and time. Recommend approval with the following stipulations:

- Public Safety Dispatch (508-647-9500) to be notified when the roadway is going to be closed, and again when it is re-opened. All roadways shall be opened no later than **8pm**.
- Nothing be erected or placed in the roadway that cannot be easily removed in the event an emergency response is needed
- Residents in the affected area to be notified in writing prior to the event date
- Nothing be placed on, or around a fire hydrant that cannot be easily moved. Fire hydrants shall not be blocked.
- Whittier Road to be closed at Oxford Street and at Orchard Street.

Additionally:

• Traffic cones and/or barricades may be checked out from Police Headquarters the morning of the event, and returned immediately following.

Reminder:

All laws relative to alcoholic beverages including the possession/carrying of same remain in effect.

Jennifer, I wanted to let you know that I spoke with the Director of the DPW. The final surface coat on Whittier Road is not anticipated to take place before the third week in October, and maybe later, so the request I will put on the agenda for the Board of Selectmen's approval will be for Whittier Road between Oxford and Orchard on Saturday, October 13th (RD: October 14th) from 4-8 PM (the Police Department will require that the road be reopened by 8:00 PM -- you had requested 9:00 PM). I will be in touch after the 9/17 Selectmen's Meeting to let you know whether or not your request was approved.
