Natick Opioid Overdose Data

- As of October 2017:
 - 19 non-fatal opioid overdoses
 - 4 fatal opioid overdoses
- As of October 2018:
 - 15 non-fatal opioid overdoses
 - 2 fatal opioid overdoses
- Post-overdose connections to treatment/support in 2018: 7
 - Some individuals unable to be contacted
 - Many individuals already engaged in treatment due to hospital referral and/or family engagement

- Cocaine
- Benzodiazepines
 - Xanax
 - Klonopin
 - Ativan
- Alcohol

Hepatitis Rates Increasing Throughout MA

- 31 new cases of Hepatitis in Natick as of October 2018
 - 1 Hepatitis A
 - 10 Hepatitis B
 - 20 Hepatitis C
- Ages range from 28 to 71

Naloxone (Narcan) Distribution Program 2018

- 9 group trainings delivered to Natick municipal departments, community organizations and businesses
 - 112 employees and volunteers trained
 - 22 Narcan kits distributed

60 individuals trained to carry Narcan

Community Education Events 2018

 6 educational speakers and workshops on prevention attended by approximately 1,094 individuals

• 9 resource center workshops on addiction and recovery attended by 61 individuals (resources, treatment navigation and Narcan distribution offered at each workshop)
