Bid Alternate 1

Warrant Article Spring ATM 2020

On December 18, 2019 bids were received for the construction of roadway improvements to South Main Street. As discussed previously with the Board, the solicitation for bids included a base bid and one bid alternate. The bid alternate is for the construction of sidewalk on the south/east side of South Main Street from Hunter's Lane south to West Street. The attached graphic and rendering depict the location of this sidewalk extension.

The engineer's estimate for the sidewalk extension (Bid Alternate 1) was \$307,320. R.M. Pacella, the qualified and responsive low bidder for the project submitted an itemized price of \$327,059.75 for the sidewalk extension (Bid Alternate 1). The base bid submitted by R.M. Pacella was Therefore, should the Selectmen wish to award the base bid along with Bid Alternate 1 for the sidewalk extension, the total construction contract would be \$4,661,466.75. The below summarize possible funding alternatives for award of the Base Bid + Bid Alternate 1 and another for the base bid only.

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Should the Board of Selectmen chose to include the sidewalk extension (Bid Alternate 1) in their construction award; several permanent easements should be pursued (90 sf sidewalk easement over #184 South Main Street and easements for a retaining wall over the properties of #166, #170, and #174 South Main Street). The attached graphics depict the location of these easements. Prior to receipt of permanent easements, rights-of-entry may be used for access.

As noted previously, the existing roadway encroaches on three properties where intersection "roundings" are missing in historic the roadway layout. The proposed roadway construction reduces these encroachments. We are coordinating with the property owners and are seeking theses small easements at no cost. The attached show the small roadway easements needed at West Street (15 sf), Walcott Street (5 sf), and Cross Street (30 sf).



Draft Town Meeting Warrant Article

South Main Street Right of Way Acquisition (Board of Selectmen)

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire by gift, purchase, taking by eminent domain, or otherwise, to accept a deed or deeds to the Town of fee simple, easements or other interests in any land, and to dedicate all or portions of Town owned parcels of land, necessary for the construction of the South Main Street roadway improvements project located on South Main Street (Route 27) from the Sherborn town line to the Town Center, as shown on and identified on a set of plans entitled XXXXXXXXX dated XXXX, prepared by Green International Affiliates, Inc., as revised or amended. Further, to see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow or transfer from available funds, to fund said purchase or takings along with all legal and appraisal costs associated with the obtaining any interests in land necessary for the construction of the South Main Street roadway improvements project;

Or otherwise to act thereon.










Existing - Facing North at Bear Hill Road

Proposed - Facing North at Bear Hill Road






Roadway Easement
