

TEMPORARY LICENSE

On June 1, 2020, Governor Charlie Baker issued an Order Clarifying the Progression of the Commonwealth's Phased Workplace Re-Opening Plan and Authorizing Certain Re-Opening Preparations at Phase II Workplaces, which, in part, details the process for reopening establishments for on-premises consumption.

This is to certify that the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Natick has granted a temporary license to:

Trend Pure Asian Cuisine – 1400 Worcester Street

DESCRIPTION OF OUTDOOR PREMISES:

Outdoor dining area in a portion of the parking area directly across the access lane from the existing restaurant entrance. This area will permit space for 11 tables with a total capacity of up to 44 diners. The outdoor dining area will be enclosed by interlocking metal pedestrian barriers.

FOR THE SALE OF: S12 On Premise all alcohol beverages

This license is granted and accepted upon the express condition that the license shall, in all respects conform to all the provisions of the Liquor Control Act, Chapter 138 of the General Laws as amended, and any rules or regulations made thereunder by the Board of Selectmen.
