

Good Morning,

I hope this email finds you well.

You are receiving this email since you have expressed interest in the MBTA's Natick Center Station Project. Construction activities are underway and will continue until 2022. The station will remain open during construction. The attached flyer was hand-delivered to areas surrounding the station this week.

Over the next two-three weeks our contractor will be hauling heavy crushed stone (ballast) for railroad bed improvements via Mechanic Street to their yard and along a portion of the Cochituate Rail Trail. Approximately 3 truckloads per day. The ballast will then be placed onto the track bed over the course of a weekend in early August. This weekend work will be happening continuously on the inbound track, including over Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. It is important to note that construction activities along the railroad right-of-way must be performed during times of little or no train activity for worker and public safety reasons. In addition, utility relocation/upgrades, along with building temporary station platforms, regrading approach ramps and other construction activities are ongoing at the Natick Center site.
