Weekly Pasta Night on Wednesday, open to the public.

Quarterly Porchetta Night dinner, open to the public.

Natick Days booth, open to the public.

Fundraising events for the Natick Service Council, Toys for Tots, Provision

Ministries, Scholarships for local senior high students, Natick VNA, ALZ Assoc. etc.

Seasonal events, dinner dances, private hall rentals, Lodge member parties.

As you are aware, the last 9 months of 2020, prevented the Lodge from performing fundraising efforts as we have done in the past. However, keeping in sync with our past giving history, we were able to donate \$8500 to local graduating high school seniors in June 2020. We distributed the scholarships in \$500 and \$250 increments, allowing us to distribute 18 scholarships. Two of these scholarships were recognizing student volunteers from Night High School: Brendan Carroll and Logan Pfahler. Brendan was incredibly helpful in the kitchen and serving at Pasta Night, arriving early, staying late, and helping in every capacity needed. Logan Pfahler designed and built the Lodge website for his senior year capstone project. We could not be prouder of these students and their support of the Lodge.

I am attaching our June 2020 Scholarship award newsletter for your information.

We also surpassed another incredible milestone in the history of our Lodge, We launched a fundraising effort in October 2019, and were able to install a mobility ramp at the Lodge to provide greater access to our community. Needham Bank selected us as a community partner and with incredible generosity from our patrons and volunteers, the ramp was installed in July 2020. This is warp speed in Lodge timing in and tremendous addition to our legacy.

To wrap up our 2020 activities, we successfully launched Online ordering with Curbside Pick-up for a Take-out Pasta Night experience. We ensured every aspect of Pasta Night was compliant with the Town and State reopening requirements and COVID-19 safety/prevention. We served 450 dinners over 6 weeks, welcoming our community back. It was truly a joy to serve together and see our Pasta Night family.

2021 begins with many unknowns, but we will continue to expand our view, reach, and impact the best we are able. We will proceed with safety as our top priority.

#### Natick Sons Of Italy Lodge #1411-2020 Scholarship essay

My name is Brendan Carroll. I have been Volunteering at the Natick Sons of Italy since the Fall of 2019. Volunteering at the Sons of Italy in Natick has provided me with a really unique opportunity to meet people who are passionate about their Italian heritage, Italian food, and Community involvement. I would like to be a recipient of the Francesco DeSanctis Lodge #1411 Scholarship Award for my strong Italian ancestry, volunteering time for the Wednesday pasta nights and my athletic and academic achievements.

I have spoken with several lodge members about their Italian heritage and where they are from. I was told quickly by some senior volunteers that if someone is yelling at you, they are not actually mad but their voice is just loud. I know this to be true from my own family. Some people don't like the 'old school' way of handling obstacles, but it was more of a reason for me to come back the following weeks because it reminded me of exactly how my family operated. I did not expect to like volunteering at the Sons of Italy as much as I do and I certainly didn't expect to get so much out of it in return. Between high school sports, Club sport, school work load, my part time job, and volunteering, I have a busy schedule. My time at the Sons of Italy has been enjoyable and something I look forward to each week.

At one of the Pasta Nights, I met a volunteer who used to be the Natick High volleyball coach before the current coach. This was another great conversation and opportunity I otherwise wouldn't of had. I play volleyball for Natick High School and Beantown Club Volleyball. I start at outside hitter and this year I am the Captain of the team. My goal this year is to win the State Championship, after losing in that final game last year. My Wednesday night practices worked out to be at the perfect time so I could do both volleyball and the Sons of Italy Pasta Night. I have made Honor Roll all 4 terms last year and High Honors for this current year.

I am applying for this Scholarship in hopes it will contribute towards my future goal of extending my career to the collegiate level of volleyball.. This Scholarship would have special meaning to me.
