**Augmented Costs:** The Trustees of the BFL maintain and preserve the cultural heritage of the building. Friends of the library fund special programs, museum passes and special collections.

## **COVID-19 Response:**

- 4,224 People attended 369 programs this includes in-person and on-line programs
- 27,637 Uses of the collection both physical & online. *Note: Book circulation INCREASED with curbside pickups over the same time period as prior years.*
- Staff added RFID tags to over 12,000+ items.
- Monthly Outdoor Story Walks added for safe in-person socially distanced programming.
- Collaboration with Natick Historical Society for programming and for reservations for in-person visits.
- Collaboration with COA for virtual instruction geared towards seniors on how to use Zoom and how to use online and digital resources.
