Response	The purpose of this article is to support the continued revitalization and vitality of Natick Center, which is critical as the district seeks to rebuild and encourage private investment following the COVID-19 economic crisis. The article seeks to authorize the Select Board to petition the state legislature to provide the town (though the Select Board) the ability to issue an additional 3 off-premises liquor licenses for the sale of wine and malt beverages to establishments located in the DM (Downtown Mixed Use) zoning district. Over the past 5+ years, several businesses seeking to open establishments in Natick Center, such as a cheese/provisions shop, butcher/small scale market, or other similar business, have been unwilling to open due to the lack of this type of license. The Town is currently unable to support these types of businesses that are desirable to the business mix and continued vitality of Natick Center.
