- Replacement costs range from \$2,200 to \$6,400 per dumpster (requested funding would replace 2 to 4 containers)

Replacement of 2015 Ford F-550 Hooklift (versatile) with snow plow

Vehicle will be over 7 years old at time of replacement

Over 105,000 miles and 12,000 engine hours at replacement





- First of multi-year project
- Repair/Replace Sewer Pump Stations
- 34 Sewer Pump Stations in Town
- 25-30 Year Expected Life
- "Town Line Pump Station" (installed 1951, repaired 1995)


SCADA System Updates

Upgrades and Replacement of Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) System Components

SCADA allows for remote monitoring/operation and automatic warnings/alarms for operation of over forty Water and Sewer facilities

Multi-year project

Funds will target Evergreen and Elm Bank Well Sites

Geographic Information System Cloud Migration

- Security (resilient cloud storage)
- Scalability (resources adjust to current demand)
- Better Collaboration (enable sharing across the town without duplication of effort)
- Reduce Costs (greatly reduce local server footprint, infrastructure demands managed by cloud provider)

3rd Party integration (Example: OpenGov, and other partners

leveraging GIS)





Mid-Size Excavator

- Daily use
- Efficiency/mobility/depth
- Allow flexibility for traffic control operations
