CITIZENS' CONCERNS

At their meeting of January 6, 2014, the Board of Selectmen voted to amend the policy regarding Citizens Concerns:

- 1. The purpose of the agenda item Citizens' Concerns is to provide the opportunity for the public to raise issues before the Board that are not on that meeting's agenda. The Board of Selectmen will listen to comments or questions from citizens during this portion of the agenda and take such comments and questions under advisement.
- 2. Those speaking during Citizens' Concerns should understand that it is not the intent of the Board of Selectmen to interfere with or assume responsibility held by other boards or agencies, although the Board may choose to look into matters about which citizens have concerns or issues. Citizens' Concerns is not intended to provide an avenue around proper procedures before other boards and agencies.
- 3. Any citizen addressing the Board during this section of the agenda shall be limited to five minutes.
