### A description of the function(s) or fundraising activity(ies) for which permits are sought:

Natick AMVETS Post 79 is striving to become a full service Veterans Service Organization dedicated to providing social and recreational activities designed to enhance the lives of our Veterans and our associated partners. We wish to hold a series a of fundraising events each year both for our Post and for our Community Partners . Examples of Fundraisers include:

- Turkeys for Vets. Amvets Post 79 fundraises within our community with the goal of raising funds to be
  able to provide a Thanksgiving and Holiday Meal for Veterans. In 2022 we raised approximately \$3500
  and served over 150 Veterans from the MetroWest community.
- Annual Golf Tournament (did not happen in 2020 or 2021). In previous years, Natick Amvets Post 79 held an annual Golf Tournament with proceeds of the fundraising event going directly to support the Board of Directors functional activities This year we focused on Annual and Seasonal Giving to support activities that benefit our communities Veterans and their families such as:
  - Memorial Day Cookout (all Veterans and families are welcome at no charge)
  - Socks, Shoes, Clothing Drive for Veterans
  - Veteran and Cub Scout Sporting / Mentoring Programs
  - Meals for Vets program
  - Toys for Tots / Cookies with Santa
- Meat Raffles Amvets Post 79 holds monthly "Meat Raffles" with the purpose of raising funds to support our community service programs and initiatives such as those listed above and additional ones including:
  - Veteran and Family Cookouts
  - Veteran Workshops (tailored towards Job training, Sporting, or special guest speakers to speak on Veterans initiatives such as Health and Wellness, Finance, etc)

In addition, the Natick AMVETS donates parking spaces to Natick Camp Arrowhead, the Cochitauate Rail Trail and donated space to SMILE Mass an organization dedicated to providing recreational opportunities for children with disabilities.

### Dear Applicant:

We're pleased to tell you we determined you're exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c)(19). This letter could help resolve questions on your exempt status. Please keep it for your records.

We based this determination on your representation that at least 75 percent of your members are past or present members of the Armed Forces of the United States. We also based it on your representation that substantially all of your other members, if any, are individuals who are cadets, or are spouses, widows, or widowers of past or present members of the Armed Forces of the United States or of cadets (see IRC Section 501(c)(19)).

Based on your representation that at least 90 percent of your members are war veterans and that you're organized and operated primarily for purposes consistent with your current status as a war veteran's organization, donors can deduct contributions they make to you or for your use. If, in the future, you don't meet this membership test or if your purposes, character, or method of operation changes, donors cannot deduct contributions they make to you or for your use, as provided by IRC Section 170.

Based on the information you submitted in your application, we approved your request for reinstatement under Revenue Procedure 2014-11. Your effective date of exemption, as listed at the top of this letter, is retroactive to your date of revocation.

Our records show you were previously tax exempt as a subordinate under group exemption number 0838. Because you applied for and were granted your own individual tax-exempt status, you no longer rely on your affiliation with a parent organization for recognition of your tax exemption.

## AMVETS POST 79 NATICK INC

If, in the future, you choose to become a subordinate under a group ruling, you'll lose your individual recognition of tax-exempt status. Moreover, if you become a subordinate under a group ruling and your parent organization loses its tax-exempt status, you also will lose your exempt status. To reestablish your individual tax exemption after rejoining a group exemption, you'll be required to reapply and pay the appropriate user fee.

If we indicated at the top of this letter that you're required to file Form 990/990-EZ/990-N, our records show you're required to file an annual information return (Form 990 or Form 990-EZ) or electronic notice (Form 990-N, the e-Postcard). If you don't file a required return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked.
