Good afternoon-

As you may be aware due to passage of the American Rescue Plan, Massachusetts has received a *record \$307.5 million for the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)* available this fiscal year (October 2021 to September 2022). As part of the <u>state-by-state</u> breakdown of funding, the Biden Administration reported that in addition to an annual appropriation of \$120.5 million for Massachusetts, the state received an additional \$187.1 million in funds from the American Rescue Plan – more than double the state's typical annual funding. The total of \$307.5 million is the highest amount Massachusetts has ever received in LIHEAP to help families struggling with the costs of home heating.
