Donna,

Regarding the attached One-Day-Liquor License applications we would recommend that the Selectboard, acting as the Licensing Authority for the Town of Natick, approve the applicants (NCCD) request. We are actively coordinating and planning with the NCCD. The current agreement would be closing off Adams Street at South Avenue and again at Court Street so that Beer and Wine could be served. Alcohol service and consumption would be limited to this area. In the event one or two food trucks were made part of the event additional closures would be made on Court Street at Main Street and again at the Middlesex Bank drive through exit. Food would be accessible in this area, but alcohol would not. Additional recommendations would be for one Natick Police Detail Officer to be hired by the NCCD to monitor this event and assist with vehicle and pedestrian management.

If approved by the Selectboard we will continue to work with the NCCD to make sure this is a safe and accessible event for all. Lastly, any server of alcohol will have to be in compliance with the Town's Alcoholic Beverage Service Policy.
