Whereas, John F served in the Navy during WWII reaching the rank of Seaman First Class and was awarded WWII Victory Medal, Good Conduct Medal, American Theatre Medal, Asiatic-Pacific Theater Medal, and

Whereas, the three brothers grew up at 196 West Central Street, and Whereas, the three brothers have passed and are buried at Saint Patrick's Cemetery Natick and Saint Stephen's Cemetery in Framingham, and
