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Fire Department

(Car 5 under DPW)

Safety Gear Rescue Task Force Safety Equipment

- <u>Rescue Task Force</u>: Firefighters who are trained and equipped to handle ASHER (Active Shooter Hostile Event Response) incidents.
- <u>Safety Equipment:</u> Consists of body armor (bullet proof vests) to protect FF's operating at these incidents.
- <u>Expired Equipment:</u> "torso plates" are good for 5 years.






Firefighting Foam Remediation & Replacement (PFAS)

- \$19,500 to remediate and replace old Firefighting foam
- Remediation cost may go down pending Mass Dept. of Environmental Protection funding.
- Replacement foam will be a UL approved "Green" foam.



Firefighting Foam Remediation & Replacement (PFAS)

- Department currently has 275 gallons of PFAS containing firefighting foam.
- Used for extinguishing Class B (liquid)/ high hazard fires.
- PFAS are forever chemicals linked to contamination of ground water.



Equipment for Replacement Engine

- \$115,000.00 to outfit Engine 4 which was replaced on FY 22 Capital.
- Cost escalation and inflation increased base price of truck only to within \$12,000 of total alocated budget.
- Replace older equipment with more reliable & modern equipment.



Equipment for Replacement Engine

- Cost savings: what was removed/reusing
 - Reusing the hose -\$15,000
 - Reusing extinguishers -\$950
 - High-rise equipment -\$1,750
 - Thermal Imager \$9,799(acquired under a grant)

Phone System Replacement

\$207,200 – to replace aging on premise telephone system equipment with a hosted/cloud based phone system.

Current system will reach end of life June 2023 and will need to be replaced/upgraded

Request will allow move to a hosted/cloud based system

- Work from Anywhere moves the phone system to the cloud, meets the IT Vision of creating a ubiquitous data and voice environment. Accessible from any Internet connected device desktop handset, mobile phones and tablets, desktops and laptops (PC, Mac and Chrome)
- Compliant with Keri's Law and the Ray Baum's Act
- No more administration and support of physical phone switches in each building
- Substantially increases business continuity in the event of almost any disaster pandemic, man-made or natural disaster, internal network outage, etc..
- Substantially reduces or eliminates the mean time to recovery (MTTR) the amount of time required to replace a failed physical phone switch with a new one. With a hosted/cloud based phone system, the only piece of equipment that would need to be replaced is a physical desktop handset.

Public Safety Radio

- \$1,730,000 to design and equip a complete overhaul of the public safety radio system.
- Natick Public Safety needs to change all aspects of our radio equipment including portable radios, mobile radios, transmitters, receivers and consoles to a new frequency spectrum rendering current equipment obsolete.
- This is required due to the change in T-Band Spectrum of LAN mobile radio systems used by numerous entities including public safety that is going into effect in 2023.

Replace Fire Car 5

- Replace 2011 Ford Expedition – Fire Car 5
- Over 90,000 miles and 8,000 engine hours at time of replacement
- Used daily by Fire Prevention and used in response to emergency events
- Existing vehicle has numerous maintenance issues

Replacement vehicles will have hybrid powertrains



- Replacement costs range from \$2,200 to \$6,400 per dumpster (requested funding would replace 2 to 4 containers)








Bacon Free Library/Historical Society Access Walkways




Tree Replacement




Replace Garage Doors – Police Garage

- 45,000 miles at time of replacement
- Existing vehicle has maintenance issues
- Vehicle used by Facilities and School Department for building maintenance activities. Assists with winter snow removal





West Street Landfill – Replace Gas Collection Manholes and Covers

- Replace Landfill Gas Collection Manholes and Covers
- Existing covers broken and damaged
- Replacements will improve safety for golfers and provide secure access to the gas collection system







Replace Vehicle 203 (LF-3)

- Replace 2013 Ford F-450 Dump Body Truck with snow plow
- 85,000 miles at time of replacement
- Existing vehicle has numerous maintenance issues
- Vehicle used by Land Facilities Division for maintenance of parks and fields





Stormwater Master Plan

- Preparation of a town wide storm water master plan by engineering consultants
- Evaluate condition and capacity of the town's storm water conveyance systems
- Develop solutions to alleviate flooding
- Scoping and costs for future capital improvements
- First of two appropriation requests



 - New Surface prevents subsurface damage, prolonging life of courts





Replace NHS Blade Server Purchased in 2010 as part of new High School Project

- This provides virtual servers supporting district wide services such as phones, logging into the network, internet access, ability to print and scan securely using Uniflow, security systems, HVAC controls and various academic systems.
- The high school blade servers are running the last version of software that the hardware allows to stay compatible with the new data center at Kennedy Middle School. Without maintaining this compatibility we will not have a backup site or any redundancies to host our services should a major failure occur.



Web Design & Game Design Labs

- Both of these labs have reached there 4 year useful life.
- Each of these labs runs software that demands up to date hardware to support it.
- Both of these labs are outfitted with Apple IMac computers.

Upgrades and Replacement of Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) System Components


SCADA allows for remote monitoring/operation and automatic warnings/alarms for operation of over forty Water and Sewer facilities


Funds will replace aging SCADA equipment at the Evergreen water supply site and replace sewer pump station PLC's






Sewer Collection System Repairs

- Successfully removed 1.42 MGD of I&I since 1997

Sprayer (\$60,000)

Benefits of new sprayer

- Larger tank capacity making it more efficient
- 2 foot wider boom to cover more ground
- Computerized automatic rate control system
 - More precision with applications
 - Saves preparation time
- Decreased maintenance costs (current sprayer 15 years old)
- Total hourly savings roughly \$1,500 per year or \$24,000 over the expected life of machine



Gas Tanks (\$10,000)

- Replace current system of 2 tanks on the back of the truck
- Safer not to have to drive everywhere with 2 tanks of gas on the back of the truck
- Saves time as tanks will be larger making less trips to refill
 - Currently have to make weekly trips
- Current truck has been in repairs the last few summers (as it get used for plowing) meaning for 1 to 2 months we use 10 gallon jugs to refill all the machines
