My name is Heather Claflin, and I am the Special Events Manager for the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (AFSP), Massachusetts Chapter. AFSP Massachusetts is committed to making a positive impact in our community by supporting individuals who have experienced a loss to suicide, support someone who struggles, or have personally experienced a mental health crisis. One of the ways we do this is through our annual Out of the Darkness Community Walks.

The MetroWest Community Walk to Fight Suicide is taking place at the Natick Common on October 15, 2023. Last year we raised \$49K with 310 Participants.

These events give people the courage to open up about their own connections to the cause, and a platform to create a culture that's smarter about mental health.
